Thank you for your Freedom of Information request dated 10 August 2023, in which you requested the following information which I have responded to in the right-hand column below:

<p>Personal information about participating cyclists</p> <p>I am surprised that the website for the UCI World Championships currently taking place lists the dates of birth for all competitors in the road race time trials. Is there any particular reason for this? It seems excessive to be listing personal data of this nature in the public domain. I would be interested to know the justification for it.</p>	<p>For the avoidance of doubt, the Tissot Timing website where this information is available (<a href="https://www.tissotiming.com/2023/crdwch/en-us/default/Stage/9/home/1">https://www.tissotiming.com/2023/crdwch/en-us/default/Stage/9/home/1</a>) is linked to the 2023 UCI Cycling World Championships website, but is not managed by 2023 Cycling World Championships Ltd.</p> <p>The Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) have always displayed the date of birth of the competitors on their website as this information relates to age-category competitions.</p> <p>The date of birth of competitors is also displayed on the Tissot Timing website for the same reason as the UCI timing partner for the 2023 UCI Cycling World Championships.</p>

If you wish to request a review of your application under either the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 or the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004, your request should be submitted to us in writing, or another permanent format (for example e-mail or voice recording), and be received by us within 40 days of the date of this letter. Any request for a review should also set out, in as much detail as possible, the reasons why you are not satisfied with our response or the manner in which we have dealt with your application.



If you are still not satisfied with our handling of your application after we have responded to your request for a review, you have a right to apply to the Scottish Information Commissioner for a decision on whether we have dealt with your request in accordance with the Act.
