<p>I wanted to request the recorded flight times of the helicopters being used to presumably film the event over Glasgow, over the duration of the event.</p> <p>I am interested in the volume of fuel and emissions that are related to these flight times.</p> <p>I am also interested in why drones weren't employed for this purpose, again, assuming filming is their main duty.</p>	<p>2023 Cycling World Championships Ltd does not hold the information that you have requested. If you are still not satisfied with our handling of your application after we have responded to your request for a review, you have a right to apply to the Scottish Information Commissioner for a decision on whether we have dealt with your request in accordance with the Act.
