RETIRAL OF THE VISITSCOTLAND QUALITY ASSURANCE SCHEMES

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

VisitScotland is required to have regard to island communities when carrying out its functions under the Islands (Scotland) Act 2018. This includes when it is considering policy, strategy or service decisions.

VisitScotland is obliged to undertake an Island Communities Impact Assessment where, in VisitScotland's opinion, a policy, strategy or service is likely to have an effect on an island community which is significantly different from its effect in other communities (including other island communities), in the area in which VisitScotland exercises its functions.

This statement covers the decision by VisitScotland to retire all its Quality Assurance schemes from 31 March 2025.

In VisitScotland's opinion, this decision will not differently impact any island community, therefore, an Island Communities Impact Assessment is not required. This document provides a summary of the information considered to support the strategy change and the decision not to undertake a full Island Communities Impact Assessment.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

VisitScotland has been running Quality Assurance (QA) schemes for different tourism business sectors since 1985. Since inception, each scheme has been delivered, with an identical approach and delivery method, across the whole of Scotland, including all island communities.

QA schemes are delivered through an annual (or for some sectors biennial) in-person visit to the business to assess different aspects of the visitor experience and to provide appropriate business advice during, and following the visit, in verbal and written form. There is a charge for QA schemes that is proportionate to the size of the business.

The assessment is specific to the sector type, but typically considers elements such as booking experience, management efficiency, hospitality and friendliness, quality and maintenance, cleanliness and hygiene and responsible tourism.

Consumer behaviour has changed in recent years, which has prompted tourism businesses to disengage from QA scheme participation, resulting in a significant decline in membership over several years. In line with VisitScotland's objectives to grow the value of the visitor economy, the Board and Management agree that a different approach to providing quality advice, that is more inclusive and sustainable, would ensure its work has greatest impact.

OBJECTIVE OF THE STRATEGY CHANGE

VisitScotland has been carrying out strategic reviews across its activities, to ensure it continues to deliver best economic impact for Scotland. The tourism landscape is changing, with a continually evolving digital environment.

As part of the review process, a detailed assessment has considered the role VisitScotland plays in providing quality advice to businesses.

The decision to retire the QA schemes reflects the change in consumer behaviour and the changing needs of tourism businesses. While visitors are looking to user reviews to help inform their own holiday planning, businesses are using the rich information provided by these reviews to manage their online reputation, drive their marketing, and inform their business planning and investment in their product.

It is important that VisitScotland activities reflect these changes and instead of assuring a business at a point in time, we'll focus on the delivery of information and insight to help businesses develop the visitor experience and respond to the changing needs of visitors.

Businesses value the advice and support that VisitScotland provides, as they look for insight and information to help them develop their product. Focusing on a business advice programme will allow VisitScotland to inspire quality in the tourism industry and reach more businesses.

QA member research in September 2023 showed the support that is of greatest value to the business is:

- Advice on legislation relevant to the business.
- Consumer insight and trends.
- Sustainability and digital advice.

As part of the retirement of the QA schemes, VisitScotland will be reviewing its current business advice programme. This work has already commenced and will be rolled out during 2024 and early 2025.

BUSINESS ADVICE PLAN

The tourism business advice and support programme will be delivered through a digital-first but not digital only approach.

The same digital approach will be taken across Scotland, including all island communities and will ensure maximum reach and ease of service for all locations, including all island communities.

It will signpost to the wider support services and products of national business support partners, with the ability to provide one-to-one support when it's needed most. In turn this will drive up the quality of the visitor experience and will have the potential to contribute significantly to destination and sector development at all levels, locally and nationally. The programme will be tailored, when required, to the needs of destination and sector partners, in partnership with them.

A team of business advice specialists will provide the service to all businesses free of charge, regardless of business sector or location.

ISLAND COMMUNITY CONSIDERATIONS

The QA schemes have always been delivered in exactly the same way for all Scottish locations, whether mainland or island communities; therefore, the decision to remove all QA schemes from all locations, does not discriminate between island communities and other communities.

The impact of the decision to retire the QA schemes is the same across the country, including all island communities, where we compare similar businesses or stakeholders.

ENGAGEMENT WITH STAKEHOLDERS

VisitScotland engaged with a range of industry stakeholders during the strategic review process.

These organisations represent tourism businesses across Scotland, including all the islands.

During this engagement, no organisation gave feedback to suggest that the decision to retire the QA schemes would differently or negatively affect an island community, in comparison with any other island or non-island community.

During this engagement, no organisation gave feedback to suggest that the decision to retire the QA schemes would create any potential barriers for businesses within any island community.

IN CONCLUSION

A full impact assessment is not required. In considering the proposal, VisitScotland has seen no evidence to suggest the effect on an island community is significantly different from its effect on other communities (including other island communities). The impact of the decision to retire the Quality Assurance schemes and move to a digital-first business advice model, is the same for all similar businesses and stakeholders across the country, including all island communities.


No evidence has been presented as part of the engagement that indicated any island impacts that require to be taken into account.






ISLANDS/MAINLAND % OF TOTAL BUSINESSES


